10am

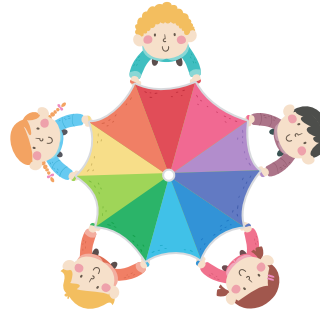

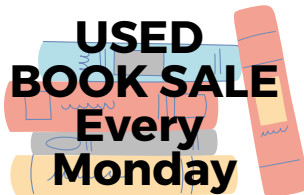

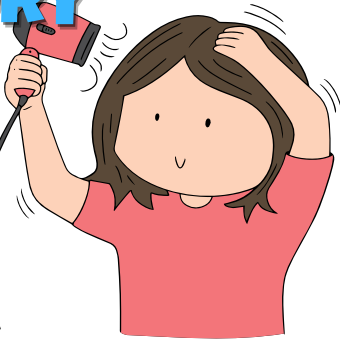
