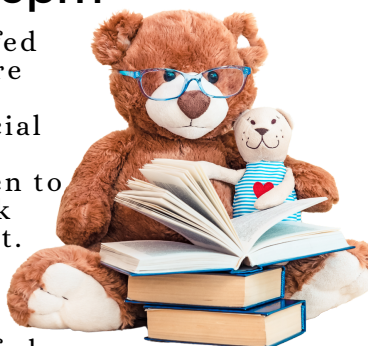

6:30pm



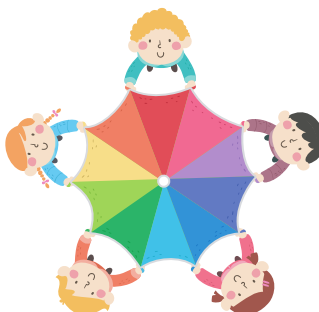

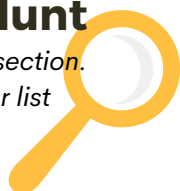

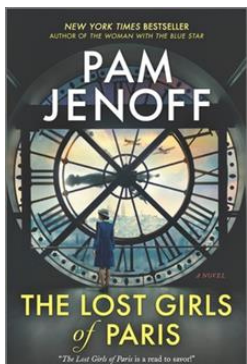

Saturday May 13, 8am-noon

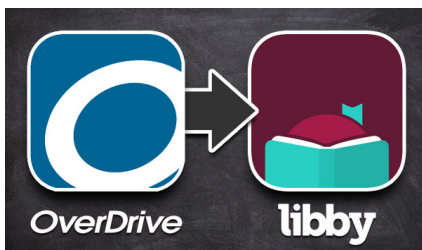
