Reports:

- Librarian's Report
In collaboration with SP CAN and Ruth Culver Library, the Teen Community Read at Sauk Prairie High School will take place across multiple weeks in April and May. There will be a Community Read again this fall.
The Friends group is planning to host another used book sale on Friday, May 15 and Saturday, May 16 (community-wide garage sale weekend)
Through March 2026, visitors to the library have increased over 34% for the same three-month period in 2025.

Business:

Mike will take a look at it and report back next month.
- Update on Purchase of Library-themed Shirts
Currently working on Summer reading-themed shirts. Should be ready by the end of May for the summer program.
- Update on Summer Library Program
Working with Ruth Culver library on a joint kick-off event. The Summer Reading Program will run June 9 through August 15.
The theme is "Unearth a Story." The adult theme will be "Digging Through the Past."

- Update on ILS Migration
Patrons can still use the computers and Wifi but can't look up books. Patrons can still check out books with their library card. Staff cannot check anything into the Library. Training went well on the 3rd, giving staff time to practice.
- Update on the Seed Library
Started the process for establishing a seed library in February. Sauk County Master Gardeners donated seeds. There are 368 varieties of flower and vegetable seeds available.
Cassie did a large amount of the work on this project.
